St. John of Capistrano



St. John was born in Capistrano, Italy, and became a lawyer and then a magistrate. He was jailed when there was a dispute with another town. This imprisonment was an opportunity to ponder his life, and he chose to serve God. John became a Franciscan, a great preacher in numerous European countries, and he was ordained in 1425. His zeal led him to help reform the Franciscan order, to work against heresies, and to spread devotion to the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary. In 1453, the Ottoman Empire took Constantinople and became an immediate threat to Europe. St. John, now seventy, was sent to gather troops in Hungary. He went into battle in Belgrade. Soon after, he died of the bubonic plague.
