St. Leonard



As a young convert living in Gaul in the fifth century, Leonard was inspired by the bishop of Rheims to amend his life. He was known for his charity to prisoners and the sick, as he not only cared for their bodily needs, but also taught them doctrine and virtuous living. When the king offered him a position in his court, Leonard declined and instead joined to a monastery, where he became a deacon. He then went to a forest to live as a hermit, where he built a chapel to the Blessed Mother. By his prayers and penance, he performed many miracles, including breaking the chains of prisoners. People joined him to pray and work. He died in about 560.
