We are still collecting for Heartbeats; send in your spare change.


## Our Lady of Prompt Succor



This title of Mary comes from Ursuline nuns in New Orleans, Louisiana. They came from France to start a convent and teach children. When some of the sisters fled in 1800 due to persecution, the Mother Superior was short on teachers. The bishop in France could not help, but allowed her to ask the pope. However, the pope had been imprisoned, and it seemed impossible he would even get her letter. She sent it with a prayer for Mary's intercession and promised to honor her as "Our Lady of Prompt Succor." Amazingly, her prayer was granted. A statue was made in France and brought by the new sisters to Louisiana. They were blessed with many miracles. Once, when the convent was in the path of a fire, the sisters stayed in the convent and prayed, and were spared.
