ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Enrollment in Mater Dei Academy is probationary for a full year pending determination that the student and parent will comply with school policies, standards and expectations. Enrollment depends upon the following:

1. **Parental Cooperation:** Cooperation of the parents in carrying out their responsibility in the Christian education of their child, adhering to school policies, standards and regulations, participating in fund raising and volunteer activities of the school, and communication with teachers and administrators upon request. School policies are outlined in the Handbook.
2. **Parental Support:** Our tuition is considerably lower than other private schools. The revenue from fundraising activities helps keep our tuition at this lower rate. Therefore, it is critical that all parents and guardians give their time to fund raising and volunteer activities throughout the year.
3. **Student Ability:** The child must be willing and able to participate in the educational program within the general range of ability of the student body. To effectively meet the needs of students, the school must be assured of each child's ability to function satisfactorily within the confines of its program and resources. We will neither enroll nor retain students unable to respond appropriately to our program, nor whose needs are unable to be effectively met within our program and resources.
4. **Student Conduct:** Appropriate student conduct is expected at all times which includes the demonstrated respect for the Catholic Church and its teachings. The Code of Conduct outlines behavioral expectations for all students. Good discipline is essential and therefore demanded consistently. All students are expected to participate in the religious life of the school, including religion classes, liturgical events and service projects.
5. **Tuition:** Tuition must be paid according to school policy and guidelines. Parents have an obligation for the financial support of the school, which includes the full and complete payment of tuition according to the plan selected.
