We are still collecting for Heartbeats; send in your spare change.


## Saint Margaret Clitherow



Margaret was a married woman in England during persecution the 1500s. She had three children. At age 18, she converted to Catholicism and got in trouble for skipping Anglican services. She also made hiding places for priests to live and celebrate Mass in secret. This was very risky, but Margaret remained virtuous and faithful even in prison. Around the age of 30, she was arrested for the last time during a raid. She was condemned to death by pressing which caused her great fear, but she went to her execution joyfully on Good Friday. Through the torture, she did not plead guilty or innocent, as she did not want the judges to put her family on trial. Margaret was one of the Forty Martyrs of England and Wales.
