St. Agnes

St. Agnes was born in 291 AD. She was very beautiful and born into a wealthy Christian



family. Her hand was highly sought after for marriage including high ranking men. But Agnes' love for God was so great she made a promise to never stain her purity. When any man offered her marriage, Agnes would always say "Jesus Christ is my only Spouse." All the men she turned

away became very angry and insulted. One of the men was Procop, the son of the Governor. Procop turned Agnes in to his father for being a Christian. And when Agnes still refused to marry Procop, she was condemned to death. St. Agnes is known as the patron saint of young girls. Her feast day is January 21st. On her feast day, it is customary for two lambs to be brought to the Pope to be blessed. On Holy Thursday, the lambs' wool is removed and woven into the pallium the Pope gives a newly consecrated archbishop as a sign of his power and union with the Pope.
