St. Brigid of Ireland

Brigid was born into slavery and raised by Druids in Ireland in 451. As a child, Brigid heard St.



Patrick preach. She also is said to have performed miracles. As well as feeding and healing the poor. At the age of ten, Brigid's father took her to the King with intent of selling her. He was tired of her charity. The King, who was also a

Christian, recognized her holiness and convinced her father to grant her freedom. Upon her freedom, Brigid returned to the Druids and her mother. Her mother was a slave to the Druids and worked in their dairy.

St. Patrick of Ireland, who heard her final vows upon entering into the convent, believed Brigid was destined for great things. She founded a double monastery in Kildare, an art school and many convents all over Ireland. Her extraordinary spirituality, charity and compassion for those distressed were legendary. St. Brigid's feast day is February 1st. She is the patron saint of Ireland, dairymaids, midwives, Irish nuns, and newborn babies.
