St. Hugh of Grenoble

St. Hugh of Grenoble was born in 1053 in the Dauphine region of France. Hugh showed piety and theological facility from a young age. While still a layman, Hugh became a canon of the cathedral in Valence.



In 1080 Hugh was named bishop of Grenoble. After, Hugh attempted a massive reform of the diocese but was discouraged. He then retired to Chaise Dieu Abbey and became a Benedictine. Hugh gave St. Bruno the land on which the Grande Chartreuse was founded, thus

starting the Carthusian Order. St. Hugh was canonized by Pope Innocent II two years after his death. His feast day is April 1st.
