St. Julie Billiard

St. Julie of Billiard was born in 1751 in France. Julie loved to play school as a child. When she turned sixteen, she preached the gospel to farm workers to help support her family. Julie carried on this mission of teaching throughout her lifetime and had a great love for Jesus in the Eucharist. When the French Revolution broke out,



Julie offered her home as hiding for local priests. During this time, she received a vision of crucified Jesus surrounded by a larger group of religious women dress in a habit she had never seen before. She realized she would begin an institute for the Christian education of

young girls. In turn, Julie and a rich companion founded the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. She was elected Mother General of the young Congregation. After nursing the wounded and hungry from the Battle of Waterloo, Julie became gravely ill and passed three months later in 1816. She was canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1969. Her feast day is April 8th. She is a Patron Saint of poverty.
