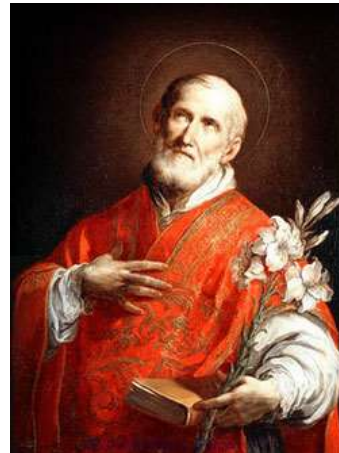

## St. Philip Neri

Born in Florence in 1515. At the age of 18 he experienced a mystical vision, which he spoke of as his Christian conversion. He felt a call from the Holy Spirit to live for and serve the Lord and his Church.



Philip had a knack for leading conversation and teaching. He was an evangelist and loved leading his brothers and sisters to do good. He spent 13 years involved in prayer and building relationships with people from all walks of life. While his days were spent preaching and

helping others, he lived his private life as a hermit. He spent much time in prayer in the catacombs and only ate bread and water. Philip had so many followers in Rome, a large room was built over the church of San Girolamo. Philip was the founder of the Congregation of the Oratory. After many years of dedication, Philip died in 1595 at 80 years old. He was canonized in 1622 and is the patron saint of Rome, US Special Forces, humor and joy. His feast day is May 26.
