## St. Dominic Savio



St. Dominic Savio was born in 1842 in northern Italy. His family was poor but devout and pious Catholics. As a small child Dominic loved the Lord and His Church. He attended Mass daily, encouraged others to pray, and was an exceptional student. In 1854, Dominic was introduced to Fr. Bosco. Fr. Dominic expressed interest in

becoming a priest and asked to go to Turin to attend the Oratory of St. Francis de Sales. Fr. Bosco agreed to take him. At the Oratory, Dominic studied directly under Fr. Bosco. At the same time Dominic was developing as a fantastic student, his health began to fail. Dominic was sent home from the Oratory to recover. Everyone expected Dominic to recover, except for Dominic himself who insisted he was dying. Dominic died at the age of 14 on March 9, 1857. Dominic's father wrote to Fr. Bosco to report the sad news. Fr. Bosco was so touched by Dominic, he wrote a biography, "The Life of Dominic Savio." As people across Italy learned of Dominic, they called for his canonization. Dominic Savio was canonized in 1954 by Pope Pius XII. St. Dominic Savio is the patron saint of choirboys, the falsely accused, and juvenile delinquents. His feast day is May 6<sup>th</sup>.
