- If you have not already done so, please sign and return interim reports to school.

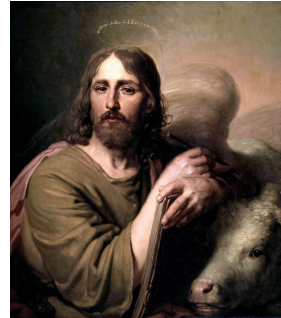
Taco Tuesday information for our new families:

St. Luke



St. Luke was born in Antioch Syria. He trained as a physician and ministered to the poor. Luke was a disciple of Paul. He traveled with Paul to spread the gospel. When Paul was persecuted by the

Romans, Luke did not abandon him. He stayed with him until the end of Paul's life.

Luke is considered an accurate historian. Many of his accounts have been verified by historians today. Luke wrote the Book of Luke and Acts of the Apostles. He also wrote of some of Jesus' miracles and parables that are not found in other gospels. He recorded about Mary. Including the Annunciation, and the words that Mary spoke that have become part of the Hail Mary prayer. The end of Luke's life is unknown. It is believed that he was martyred by the Romans. His feast day is October 18th. He is the patron saint of physicians and surgeons.
